

The STOMP THE YARD National Step Battle Brought To You By Sony Pictures

CONTEST RULES NO PURCHASE NECESSARY VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW

1. Contest Description. The STOMP THE YARD National Step Battle Brought To You By Sony Pictures (“Contest”) begins on or about December 9, 2006 and ends on or about December 17, 2006 (“Contest Entry Period”). The initial phase of the Contest consists of live competitions that take place at various Event Locations (defined below) across the country. For a list of Event Locations and date of entry/ entry deadline for each event location, please visit www.stomptheyard.com (“Web Site”). The Contest consists of a skill-based competition whereby eligible entrants (“Step Team Members”) who are members of amateur (non-professional) step-dance teams (each a “Step Team”) of no fewer than five (5) and no more than twelve (12) members: (1) appear at the specified time at a particular participating event location (“Event Location”) (as described in paragraph 4 below); (2) complete the necessary documentation, and (3) perform (in accordance with these Contest Rules) their original group step-dance routine (“Routine”) for a chance to win a trip to New York City to see a pop music concert or a trip to Los Angeles to attend a film premiere (subject to the judging stages described below); as well as attend a screening of STOMP THE YARD (“The Picture”) in the general area where the Step Team Captain (described below) resides. STEP TEAM MEMBERS (IF A MINOR, PARENT/ LEGAL GUARDIAN ON HIS/HER BEHALF) AGREE THAT PARTICIPATION IN THIS CONTEST IS SUBJECT AT ALL TIMES TO COMPLIANCE WITH THESE CONTEST RULES AND WITH ALL APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAWS.

2. Contest Entities. The sponsor of the Contest is Columbia TriStar Marketing Group, Inc. (“Sponsor”), located at 10202 West Washington Blvd. Culver City, CA 90232. Sponsor, Skycastle Entertainment, Inc., Sullivan Compliance Company, and each of the foregoing entities’ affiliates and other related entities, their respective prize suppliers, authorized designees, radio stations, promotional partners, event, screening, and concert locations, and any other individual or entity associated with the development, judging or administration of this Contest shall be referred to hereunder as the “Contest Entities.” Employees, officers, and directors, of the Contest Entities, as well as members of their immediate families (spouses, children, siblings, parents), and/or persons living in the same household as such persons, whether or not related, are not eligible to participate in the Contest.

3. Eligibility. The Contest is open only to current legal residents of the 50 states of the United States of America and the District of Columbia, who warrant and represent that they and/or Step Team Members and Routines, as applicable, meet all of the following requirements:

- i. They are thirteen (13) years of age or older as of December 9, 2006;
- ii. They are amateur Step Teams of no fewer than five (5) and no more than twelve (12) members. (Amateur status means that the team/members have won fewer than 20 competitions and been paid no more than 20 times in the 2006 calendar year in prize monies and/or performance fees);
- iii. They are not subject to any performance agreement or any similar agreement which would interfere with their ability to enter this Contest and/or grant all of the rights to be granted hereunder;
- iv. They have carefully reviewed prior to agreeing to, agreed to, completed and signed, (and/or notarized if applicable as stated below) the Release of Liability, Indemnification and Assumption of Risk Agreement and Affidavit of Eligibility, Liability Release and (where legal) Publicity Release (collectively “Entry/Affidavit

Release Form”). If a prospective Step Team Member is a resident of a jurisdiction that deems him/her to be a minor, he/she must either have his/her parent/legal guardian complete and sign an Entry/Affidavit Release Form on site at an Event Location before an authorized event location administrator or have the signature of his/her parent/legal guardian notarized on such document if the parent/guardian is unable to accompany the minor to the Event Location. To obtain the Entry/Affidavit Release Form on-line visit www.stomptheyard.com and/or obtain at the designated registration area at each Event Location.

- v. At the scheduled time at the Event Location, they are ready/prepared to perform their Routine adhering to each of the following requirements, such a Routine, an “Eligible Routine”: (1) is no longer than two (2) minutes; (2) does not contain or depict any objectionable, unlawful, defamatory, obscene, sexually explicit, threatening, abusive, harassing, hateful, discriminatory, threatening, vulgar, racially or ethnically-motivated, invasive of another’s privacy, or any other objectionable material or gesture or is otherwise unfit for publication/posting/uploading, as determined by Sponsor in its sole and absolute discretion; (3) does not contain, or otherwise make available any materials (images, sounds, music, trademarks, logos, etc.) that infringe upon any personal, proprietary or any other right of any third party; (4) does not contain any visual or audio references to alcoholic beverages, tobacco, drug paraphernalia, firearms, or any depiction or representation thereof; (5) does not contain or otherwise make available any unsolicited or unauthorized advertising, promotional materials, or any other form of solicitation; (6) does not contain any elements that would give or threaten to give rise to criminal or civil liability; encourages conduct that constitutes a criminal offense; or encourages or provides instructional information about illegal activities.

4. How to Enter. In order to participate in the Contest, entrants must listen for Contest announcements in local media or publicity within their local participating market for details on the Event Location in their area. There may be up to thirty-eight (38) Event Locations around the United States. Each Event Location will have its own entry date(s) and time(s). Information on participating event locations as well as updates will be posted on the Web Site throughout the Contest Period. Event Locations and their corresponding entry dates are subject to change in Sponsor’s sole discretion. Additional Event Location(s) may be added at Sponsor’s sole discretion and will be posted at the Web Site. Contest announcements will invite prospective Step Teams to appear at their participating Event Location to perform their Routine, in accordance with these Contest Rules.

IN ORDER TO BE ABLE TO PHYSICALLY ENTER A STEP TEAM ROUTINE, STEP TEAM MEMBERS MUST MEET AT THE SAME EVENT LOCATION DURING THE COMPETITION EVENT DATE FOR THAT EVENT LOCATION.

An entry consists of an Eligible Routine exhibited by eligible Step Team Members who as part of the entry into the Contest have also provided and submitted accurate and complete Entry Information (as defined below) in accordance with these Contest Rules.

To enter this Contest, each Step Team Member (or his/her parent/legal guardian if Step Team Member is a resident of a jurisdiction that deems him/her to be a minor) must read, complete and agree to the following:

- (a) Each Step Team Member (if a minor, parent/ legal guardian on his/her behalf) must register by legibly hand-printing, completing and submitting the Entry/Affidavit Release Form. Registration information includes: Event Location, Event Date, Step Team Name, entrant First & Last Name, Complete Home Address (no P.O. Boxes), Date of Birth, Parent/Legal Guardian’s Name (if a Step Team Member is a resident of a jurisdiction that deems him/her to be a minor), email address (optional), Daytime Telephone Number (including area code),

Evening and/or Mobile Telephone Number (including area code; and the contact information of the designated Step Team Member (i.e. his/her Name and Telephone Number) that can be used to identify your Step Team and who will take responsibility as the main contact person for your Step Team (“Step Team Captain”) (collectively “Entry Information”);

- (b) Each Step Team Member (or parent/legal guardian if Step Team Member is a minor) must sign his/her Entry/Affidavit Release Form and complete any other document supplied by Sponsor and/or the respective Event Location Administrators. Proof of identification may be requested. All required Entry/Affidavit Release Form information and Entry Information must be completed in full. Each Step Team Member must complete his/her Entry/Affidavit Release Form using the exact same Step Team name and Step Team Captain name as all of his/her respective Step Team Members.
- (c) After each Step Team Member’s registration and Entry/Affidavit Release Form is received and verified by the Event Location Administrator(s) at the Event Location, Step Team Captain will then receive (on behalf of the Step Team) one (1) ticket that contains the scheduled performance time that day at the Event Location for the exhibition of the Step Team’s Routine. Performance times are ordered on a first come, first to perform basis. If a Step Team Member or a given Step Team is not present at indicated location within five (5) minutes of its scheduled Step Team’s performance time as determined by Event Location Administrator(s) at its sole discretion, Step Team may need to obtain a new performance time (if available) or such Step Team will be disqualified at Event Location representative’s sole discretion. Event Location Administrator(s) clock is the official time for the Contest.
- (d) At the scheduled time, all Step Team Members must perform live together for up to two (2) minutes (timed by Event Location Administrator(s)) at the applicable Event Location. All Routines must be performed without music and within the Contest Entry Period for a participating Event Location. Small, manageable props are allowed but no water, pyrotechnics, smoke machines, fog machines, or weapons allowed or Routine will be disqualified. Usage of any props are at the sole discretion of the Event Location Administrator(s).
- (e) EACH STEP TEAM MEMBER (IF A MINOR, PARENT/ LEGAL GUARDIAN ON HIS/HER BEHALF) AGREES TO BE BOUND BY THESE CONTEST RULES.
- (f) Each Step Team Member (if a minor, parent/ legal guardian on his/her behalf) specifically agrees to be bound by the **DISCLAIMERS AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY; DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES CLAUSE** set forth in paragraph 12 of these Contest Rules.
- (g) Each Step Team Member (if a minor, parent/ legal guardian on his/her behalf) specifically agrees to be bound by the **ARBITRATION; WAIVER OF INJUNCTIVE RELIEF; GOVERNING LAW CLAUSE** set forth in paragraph 14 of these Contest Rules.
- (h) Each Step Team Member (if a minor, parent/ legal guardian on his/her behalf) specifically agrees that Routines performed in violation of these requirements or the instructions of the event judges/Event Location Administrator(s)/Sponsor as determined by the event judges/Event Administrator(s)/Sponsor, in the sole discretion of either party, will be disqualified and any attempted form of entry into this Contest other than as described herein is void.
- (i) By entering Contest, each Step Team Member (if a minor, parent/ legal guardian on his/her behalf) represents and warrants that he/she and/or team is/are not subject to any agreement or arrangement, including without limitation, any dance and/ or Step Team Routine or any similar other agreement that would interfere with his/her/team entering this Contest and assigning all the rights assigned hereunder.

5. General Restrictions. Each Step Team Member may only participate and complete his/her registration at the Event Location with one (1) Step Team. **LIMIT ONE (1) ENTRANT PER / STEP TEAM / PER LOCATION THROUGHOUT THE CONTEST PERIOD.** Should the same person attempt to enter in excess of the limit stated above, only his/her first entry and Step Team Routine will be considered and all subsequent Step Team / registrations /by such person will be disqualified. All required Entry Information must be completed in full. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to make any changes to the Event Locations including adding additional Event Locations or eliminating listed Event Locations (e.g., cancellation due to inclement weather or for any other reason) and shall not incur any liability resulting from any such changes. Proof of submitting, delivery or receipt of registration documents will not be deemed by Sponsor as proof of entry. Any attempted form of entry into this Contest other than as described herein is void and will be disqualified.

6. Additional Representation and Warranty. By submitting an entry, each Step Team Member (if a minor, parent/ legal guardian on his/her behalf) represents and warrants to Sponsor that his/her Routine (i) is his/her/group original Step Team creation, (ii) has not been copied in whole or in part from any other work, (iii) does not violate or infringe any copyright, trademark, privacy, publicity or other proprietary right of any person or entity, (iv) is his/her/group sole and exclusive property, and (v) is otherwise an Eligible Routine.

7. Licensing of Registration/Routine to Sponsor. By entering the Contest, each Step Team Member (if a minor, parent/ legal guardian on his/her behalf) agrees to grant to Sponsor, its affiliates and authorized designees, the rights granted pursuant to the Entry Affidavit/Release Form, as provided for in the Entry Affidavit/Release Form.

8. Judging Stages, Judging Criteria, Public Voting: This Contest consists of three (3) judging stages (in order): 1) Semi-Finalist Judging at Event Location; 2) Finalist Judging; and 3) Public Voting. Eligible Routines performed at a particular Event Location within the guidelines described by the Event Location Administrator(s) and these Contest Rules will be judged live during performance of Routines by event location judges (“Event Location Judges”). The decisions of Event Location Judges shall be final and binding in all respects. All judging of each Step Team’s Eligible Routine will be based upon the following criteria (the “Judging Criteria”):

Originality	Evaluate the performance and how the team incorporates unique and creative elements to the performance.	0-50 points
Style	Rate the overall look and effect of the team's performance.	0-25 points
Execution	Assess how well the team performs together as a whole.	0-25 points

The scores from the three categories will be totaled together for each Routine for a preliminary score from each judge, making the best possible preliminary score a perfect 100. All of the Routine’s preliminary scores from each of the Event Location Judges will then be averaged together for the Step Team’s final score; again, best possible score being 100 points. Among all the eligible Step Teams who performed Eligible Routines, Event Location Judges will select one (1) potential semi-finalist Step Team whose Eligible Routine is judged the highest at its respective Event Location, subject to final verification of eligibility and compliance with these Contest Rules (“Semi-Finalist Team”). Event Location Judges will also select one (1) potential runner up Step Team whose Eligible Routine is judged the second highest at its respective Event Location, subject to final verification of eligibility and compliance with these Contest Rules (“Runner Up Team”). **Step Teams who performed Eligible Routines must be present at the time the results are announced.** The decisions of Event Location Judges at this stage of the judging shall be final and binding in all respects; and shall not be subject to review or change by

Sponsor, Event Administrator(s) or any other third party, except if and to the extent otherwise provided in these Contest Rules. In the event of a tie, the tied Step Team who scored higher in the “Originality” criterion will be declared the potential Semi-Finalist Team. In the event of a further tie, the tied Step Team who scored higher in the “Style” criterion will be declared the potential Semi-Finalist Team. If needed, Event Location Judges will re-score the tied Eligible Routines until the relevant tie is broken. If a potential Semi-Finalist Team or Step Team Member is found to be ineligible or does not otherwise comply with these Contest Rules, such potential Semi-Finalist Team will be disqualified, and no Semi-Finalist Team will be awarded at that Event Location. **Once the potential Semi-Finalist Team is announced at the Event Location, the Semi-Finalist Team must perform the same Eligible Routine with the same Step Team Members, as entered and performed, as well as agree to be videotaped by representatives of the Sponsor in its sole discretion for the Finalist & Public Voting stage (“Step Team Video”).** Respective Event Location Judges have the right, in their sole discretion, to select no Semi-Finalist Team or Runner Up Team based on an insufficient number of Eligible Routines.

Finalist Judging. On or about December 20, 2006 judging of all Semi-Finalist Routines taped on the Step Team Videos received from each Event Location will be conducted by studio executives (“Finalist Judges”). Finalist Judges will select up to five (5) potential finalists (or fewer, or none, if fewer or no potential Semi-Finalist Teams or Routines are eligible, in the sole discretion of Sponsor) (“Finalist Team”) among all the potential Semi-Finalist Teams in accordance with the Judging Criteria. The decisions of Finalist Judges shall be based on the Judging Criteria and shall be final and binding in all respects. Eligible Routines received the highest scores, will be declared a potential Finalist Teams. In the event of a tie, the tied potential Semi-Finalist Team who scored higher in the “Originality” criterion will be declared one of the potential Finalist Teams. In the event of a further tie, the tied potential Semi-Finalist Team who scored higher in the “Style” criterion will be declared one of the potential Finalist Teams. If needed, Sponsor will re-score the tied Eligible Routines until the relevant tie is broken. If a potential Finalist Team or Step Team Member is found to be ineligible or does not otherwise comply with these Contest Rules, such potential Finalist Team will be disqualified, and the potential Semi-Finalist Team with the next highest eligible score, if any, will be declared a potential Finalist Team. The new selectee will also have to comply with all the terms and conditions of these Contest Rules (including, without limitation, all eligibility requirements) to be deemed a potential Finalist Team. Routines and Step Team Videos, which are not reasonably pertinent to the Judging Criteria (described above), as determined by Sponsor and/or Event Location Judges and/or Finalist Judges in their sole discretion, or are otherwise in violation of these Contest Rules, will be disqualified. As determined by Sponsor, Event Location Judges and Finalist Judges in their sole discretion, Routines and Step Team Videos that include obscenities, objectionable material, defame or invade the publicity or privacy rights of any person, living or deceased, or otherwise infringe upon any third party’s personal or proprietary rights will be disqualified. Executed Entry/Affidavit Release Form, which among other things, assigns to the Contest Entities all rights to the use of the Step Team’s Routine and Step Team Video to be made thereof as otherwise provided herein and release all rights to bring any claim, action, or proceeding against the Contest Entities. Step Team Videos are used for judging purposes, are the sole property of the Sponsor, and will not be distributed or released to Step Teams or Step Team Members.

Public Voting. Beginning at 6:00:01 p.m. Pacific Time (“PT”) on December 27, 2006 and ending at 11:59:59 p.m. (PT) on January 10, 2007 (the “Public Judging Period”), the Step Team Videos of the Finalist Teams will be posted on the Web Site, in order for members of the public (“Voters”) who are 13 years or older as of December 27, 2006 and are current legal residents of one of the 50 states of the U.S. or the District of Columbia, to vote based on the Judging Criteria, for the Eligible Routine to which, in the case of each Voter, such Voter has assigned the highest score. **Limit one vote per Voter/email address per day. Limit 15 votes per person/email address during the entire Contest Period.** Each potential Finalist Team member may vote for his/her own posted Routine. All votes must be received by 11:59:59 p.m. PT on January 10, 2007 to be counted. Any attempted form of voting other than as described herein shall be null and void. The potential Finalist Team who received the most votes (placed by eligible Voters voting

in accordance with these Contest Rules) will be declared the potential grand prize winner (“GP Winner Team”). In the event of a tie, the potential Finalist Team who scored higher in the “Originality” criterion will be declared the potential GP Winner Team. In the event of a further tie, the tied potential Finalist Team who scored higher in the “Style” criterion will be declared the potential GP Winner Team. If needed, Sponsor will re-score the tied Eligible Routines until the relevant tie is broken. If a potential GP Winner Team or the Step Team’s Eligible Routine is found to be ineligible or otherwise does not comply with these Contest Rules, such potential GP Winner Team will be disqualified, and the potential Finalist Team with the next highest number of eligible votes will be declared a potential GP Winner Team. The new selectee (and their Eligible Routine) will also have to comply with all the terms and conditions of these Contest Rules (including, without limitation, all eligibility requirements) to be deemed a potential Finalist Team.

9. Notification of Finalists; Notification of Grand Prize Winner. On or about December 21, 2006, Contest Administrator will give a courtesy call to the five (5) potential Finalist Team Captains (or fewer if fewer were selected), of their potential Finalist Team status.

On or about January 11, 2007, Contest Administrator will attempt to contact by telephone the potential GP Winner Team Captain (at the telephone number(s) appearing on his/her Entry Information). During the notification call, Contest Administrator will notify the Step Team Captain of his/her Step Team’s potential Grand Prize Winner status and provide him/her information regarding the documentation that the Contest Administrator will send to the potential GP Winner Team for execution and distribution to all Step Team Members (including, without limitation, an Affidavit of Eligibility, a Liability Release, and, where legal, a Publicity Release (“Affidavit Release”), Telephone Eligibility Questionnaire, and a Travel Guest Release (if a GP Winner Team Member is a resident of a jurisdiction that deems him/her to be a minor, he/she must have his/her parent/legal guardian complete his/her Affidavit Release as well as a Travel Guest Release and accompany minor on trip), such documentation referred to as the (“Documentation”). The potential GP Winner Team Captain and all Step Team Members (and Guest(s) if applicable) will have to complete, execute and return Documentation to Contest Administrator for receipt by Contest Administrator within five (5) days from the date of the receipt of the Documents. If Contest Administrator does not receive all the requisite executed Documentation within such five (5) period or if the Documentation is incomplete or not in compliance with the instructions provided by Contest Administrator and/or these Contest Rules, such potential GP Winner Team may be disqualified and an alternate potential GP Winner Team may be selected at Sponsor’s sole discretion. The new selectee will also have to comply with all the terms and conditions of these Contest Rules to be deemed a potential GP Winner Team. If the majority of potential GP Winner Team Members are disqualified for any reason, the entire potential GP Winner Team will then be disqualified and an additional potential GP Winner Team with the next highest score will, at Sponsor’s sole discretion, be declared the potential GP Winner Team.

10. Prizes: One (1) Grand Prize, up to thirty-eight (38) Semi-Finalist Prizes and up to thirty-eight (38) Runner Up Prizes will be awarded in this Contest. The grand prize is awarded to each member of the GP Winner Team consisting of Step Team Captain’s choice of one of two trips, either: 1) round trip coach air transportation to New York, NY from a major commercial airport (as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion) near the general area where the Step Team Captain resides to New York City; standard hotel accommodations for each member of the GP Winner Team and his/her guest(s) (if applicable, see below) (single room, double occupancy) for two (2) nights; and tickets to a pop music concert (artist, date and location to be determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion (“Concert Trip”). If member of the GP Winner Team is a minor, and only if, then he/she will be allotted one (1) guest who must be his/her parent legal guardian to accompany minor on trip. If the opportunity to attend a pop music concert is not available during the 2007 calendar year for whatever reason (e.g. schedule change, production issues), or the Step Team Captain (on behalf of the Step Team Members chooses option 2), the Concert Trip (as described above) will not be awarded and the potential GP Winner Team will receive: 2) A trip to Los Angeles (if member of the GP Winner Team is a minor, and only if, then

he/she will be allotted one (1) guest who must be his/her parent legal guardian) to attend an upcoming Sony film premiere (actual "Premiere" to be determined by Sponsor at its sole discretion), consisting of round-trip coach class airfare (via an airline carrier selected by Sponsor) from the major U.S. gateway city airport near the general area where the Step Team Captain resides to Los Angeles, CA; hotel accommodations for two (2) nights (one standard room/double occupancy) at a hotel selected by Sponsor and tickets to the film's Premiere and after party ("Premiere Trip"). If the Premiere Trip is taken, GP Winner Team will need to travel during the time of the premiere, or the part of the Premiere Trip that involves attending the premiere will be forfeited Approximate Retail Value ("ARV") of Grand Prize per person: \$1,200. ARV of each Grand Prize if guest is allotted: \$2,400 ("Grand Prize") per two 2 persons. The ARV of the Grand Prize may vary depending upon the point of departure, destination, and fare fluctuations and any differences will not be awarded. Step Team Captain's decisions are binding on all members when the choice of Concert Trip or Premiere Trip, is confirmed by Step Team Captain to Sponsor or Sponsor's prize fulfillment designee. No changes can be made once travel is booked. Trip must be taken within one (1) year of notification of winning or it will be forfeited. Nothing set forth herein shall be construed to require Sponsor to hold the selected Premiere. If Premiere is cancelled, postponed, cannot take place as scheduled or at all, for reasons including but not limited to scheduling conflicts, cancellations, postponement, an event of force majeure, or for any other reason, then the potential GP Winner Team will take the trip to Los Angeles without the Premiere portion of the prize within one (1) year of notification. All Step Team Members (and guest(s) if applicable) must travel together on the same itinerary. If Premiere is cancelled or postponed during GP Winner Team's trip for any reason, Premiere portion of Prize will be forfeited and no additional substitute prize or compensation will be provided in lieu thereof. Air transportation provided only if potential GP Winner Team resides more than one hundred (100) miles from New York, N.Y. or Los Angeles, CA (the specified destination). GP Winner Team Members that are deemed minors and allotted one (1) travel guest, must travel on same itinerary as said guest. Once determined, no extension or change of trip dates permitted, except by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Trips are subject to air/ground travel availability, hotel availability, holiday and black-out dates and all other prize and travel restrictions, as applicable. **One (1) Semi-Finalist Prize will be awarded to each Semi-Finalist Team** consisting of a screening pass for each Semi-Finalist Team member and one (1) guest to attend a screening of the film STOMP THE YARD at a theatre in the general area where the Step Team Captain of the Semi-Finalist Teams' reside (or nearby theatre showing/screening in the general area where the Step Team Captain of the Semi-Finalists' resides, location to be determined at Sponsor's sole discretion); and concession coupons at the theatre ("Semi-Finalist Prize") ARV of the Semi-Finalist Prize per person & guest: \$40 (actual value depends on the number of Step Team Members and guests). **One (1) Runner Up Prize will be awarded to each Runner Up Team** consisting of a screening pass for each Runner Up Team member and one (1) guest to attend an advance screening of the film STOMP THE YARD at a theatre in the general area where the Step Team Captain of the Runner Up Teams' resides (or nearby theatre showing/screening in the general area where the Step Team Captain of the Semi-Finalists' resides, (location to be determined at Sponsor's sole discretion) ("Runner Up Prize"). ARV of each Runner-Up Prize per person & guest: \$20 (actual value depends on the number of Step Team Members and guests). The Semi-Finalist and Runner Up Prizes will be awarded to Step Teams at each Event Location.
